

Land of Lincoln Purebred Livestock Breeder's Association Scholarship

One scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded to one male or one female, between the ages of 17-20 years old by January 1 of the application year and furthering their education in an Agriculture related field. Applicants and/or their family need to be members of the LLPLBA and involved in purebred livestock. The eligible purebred livestock are: beef, dairy, goats, horses, llamas, sheep and swine as listed in the Illinois State Fair Open Premium Book.

Applications will be available by logging in to the 4-H Scholarship website and FFA Scholarship website.

All applicants must complete the scholarship application and provide the name of the Institution that they will be attending. The money will be sent directly to the Institution in the student's name.

Applications must be postmarked and returned by October 1st, 2017 to Mr. Dusty Rincker 422 State Highway 32, Stewardson, IL 62463. (Faxed copies not accepted)

The winner will be notified by November 1st. They, along with their family, will be guests at the Awards Ceremony held during the annual LLPLBA meeting on December 2nd at 11:00 am at the Northfield Inn, Springfield, Illinois.
